Floral Wire — 24-Gauge Paper Covered Green
10mm Spun Balls
6mm Spun Balls
Bearly Art Glue

① Gather your tools and materials.




② Cut the crepe paper according to template notes using scissors or a cutting machine.




③ Using a blending brush, color the ball cover with yellow PanPastel.




- 4 Blend yellow PanPastel from the base of the each petal to the center using a blending brush. Color both sides of each petal.




- 5 Glue a 10mm ball to the tip of a thick stem wire.



- 6 Glue the ball cover over the ball using white glue.



- 7 Cup the center of 2 xsmall petals, then apply glue to the inside of the cup.



- 8 Place the ball in the cup of the petal and wrap the petal tightly around the ball until the top of the petal comes to a point.



- 9 Wrap the second xsmall petal around the ball opposite of the first.



- 10 Cup and stretch the two remaining xsmall petals.



- 11 Use a curling tool to curl the top edges of the petals back.



- 12 Glue the two xsmall petals around the ball opposite of each other.




- 13 Cup and stretch the center of each small petal, then curl the top edges back using a curling tool.



- 14 Add the 4 small petals evenly around the flower.



- 15 Cup and stretch the center of each medium petal, then curl the top edges back using a curling tool.



- 16 Cut a dip into the top of some medium petals to add some variation.




- 17 Add the 6 medium petals evenly around the flower.



- 18 Cup and stretch the center of each large petal, then curl the top edges back using a curling tool.



- 19 Add the 8 large petals evenly around the flower.



- 20 Cut down into the sepal leaves to add texture.



- 21 Curl the sepal using a curling tool.



- ② Wrap the sepal around the base of the flower using white glue to attach.



- ③ Wrap the stem with a strip of juniper crepe paper.

Rose Leaves & Garden Rose Buds



- ① Gather your tools and materials.



- ② Cut out crepe paper according to template using scissors or a cutting machine with a rotary blade.




- ③ Glue the leaf halves together over a 6" 24 gauge wire using white glue.



- ④ Double pink the top edges of the leaves. (cut with the pinking shears, then cut over the same spot to cut each point in half)



- ⑤ Wrap the leaves together using a strip of crepe paper. Make 2 stems with 1 large and 4 small leaves. Make 1 stem with 1 large and 2 small leaves.



- ⑥ Glue a 6mm ball then a 10mm ball onto the tip of a 12" 24 gauge wire using hot glue.




- ⑦ Glue the ball cover light green side up to the top of the 10mm ball using white glue.



- ⑧ Wrap from the center of the 10mm ball down to the stem with a strip of green floral tape to cover the balls. Use white glue to attach.



- ⑨ Use detail scissors to cut into each point of the sepal, to add texture.



- ⑩ Wrap the sepal around the 10mm dark green side out. Use white glue to attach.



- ⑪ Wrap the wire with a strip of green crepe paper, then attach multiple buds together using the crepe paper strip and white glue.



- ⑫ To finish, add the leaf stems to the buds using a strip of crepe paper.

MATERIALS

Lia Griffith Heavy Crepe Paper — Blush
Lia Griffith Extra-Fine Crepe Paper — Juniper
Lia Griffith Double-Sided Crepe Paper — Green Tea & Cypress
PanPastel — Diarylide Yellow
Thick Stem Wire
Floral Wire — 24-Gauge Paper Covered Green
Bearly Art Glue
Cardstock

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① Gather your tools and materials.



② Cut all of the pieces according to the template notes.



③ Stretch the stamen piece as much as possible.



- ④ Trim one long edge with zig zag pinking shears.



- ⑤ Fold the trimmed edge about 1/4 inch and glue into place.



- ⑥ Add a line of glue inside fold, refold and press flat.



- ⑦ Trim the top edge of the stamen piece with zig zag pinking shears.



- ⑧ Using blending brush, color both sides of stamen strip.



- ⑨ Secure flat edge into fringe clip and fringe along grain.



- ⑩ Roll the fringe between your fingers to thin stamen.



- ⑪ Slide small cardstock disk onto thick stem wire.



- ⑫ Using white craft glue, wrap and attach the stamen around the tip of wire then secure disk at base.



- 13 With the yellow PanPastel, use blending brush to color base or each petal, blending towards center. Color both sides of petals.



- 14 Starting with Petal A, shape tips of petal with curling tool.



- 15 Turn petal and shape base of petal in same direction.




- 16 Stretch the center of petal to form a cup.




- 17 Repeat this step for all twelve Petal A pieces.



- 18 Repeat these steps with Petal B shapes.



- 19 Form a cup with each petal, stacking each size into a pile for organization.



- 20 Repeat these steps with Petal C.



- 21 Use hot glue to add petals to the center. Glue the first Petal A on top of the disk with edge touching center sepal.



- 22 Add another two of the Petal A in a triangle shape.



- 23 Offset and glue three of the Petal A shapes inside the first three, all on top of the cardstock disk.



- 24 Glue three of the Petal A pieces under the disk, offset from the petals above.




- 25 Repeat with the last three Petal A pieces.



- 26 Begin to add all of the Petal B pieces, carefully offsetting each petal to form the bloom.




- 27 The flower will begin to take shape and you can stop adding petals for a smaller flower.



- 28 For the largest flower, finish by adding the Petal C pieces.



- 29 The rose will become compact and full.



- 30 The large petals begin to fall away from the center.



- 31 Use the curling tool to add shape to the tips of each sepal.



- 32 Stretch the centers or shape with the ball tool to form a cup.



- 33 Add white glue to one tip of the sepal piece.



- 34 Place the sepal onto the wire and the back of the rose so each piece curls away from the flower.



- 35 Follow steps from the Garden Rose to create two stems of leaves with three leaves each.



- 36 Add the leaf stems to rose stem, wrapping with a thin strip of Juniper crepe secured with white glue.



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① Gather your tools and materials.



② Cut the crepe paper according to template notes using scissors or a cutting machine.



③ Stretch the heavy crepe paper stamen piece as much as possible.



- ④ Trim one long edge with zig zag pinking shears.




- ⑤ Fold the trimmed edge about 1/4 inch and glue into place.




- ⑥ Add a line of glue inside fold, refold and press flat.




- ⑦ Trim the top edge of the stamen piece with zig zag pinking shears.




- ⑧ Paint both sides of the pinked edge with a yellow paint pen.



- ⑨ Clip onto fringe clip and cut tiny fringes into the crepe paper along the grain line.



- ⑩ Roll fringe between fingers to thin stamen.



- ⑪ Remove from clip and trim off excess crepe at base of stamen fringe.



- ⑫ Roll and glue onto tip of 24-gauge wire.



- 13 Shape the top corners of the rose petals with curling tool.



- 14 Create a gentle cup with the large ball tool in the center of each petal.



- 15 Add a small line of glue on one side of base.



- 16 Place onto second petal and repeat to create a spiral of 5 petals.



- 17 Close the spiral by overlapping the petals in the same direction and set aside to dry.




- 18 Slide stamen wire through center of petals and nest the stamen base into the center.



- 19 Use needle nose tweezers to enlarge hole in the 6mm spun ball.



- 20 Slide onto the wire until it meets the base of the petals.



- 21 Snip slits into the sepal points.



22 Use curling tool to shape tips of the sepal.



23 Roll the tips between fingers to slightly spiral.



24 Add generous amount of glue at the base of the sepal piece.



25 Wrap to cover 6mm ball, allowing the stamen tips to frame the rose petals.




26 Tightly pinch and form the glue infused stamen around the ball.



27 Wrap 3-4 inches of the stem with Juniper crepe and glue.



28 Glue a 10mm spun shape onto 24-gauge wire. Shape the bud petals with the steel ball.



29 Glue first petal onto ball to form point in the center



30 Add three more petals around the ball to create a tiny bud.



- 31 Slide a 6mm ball onto wire to meet base of petals.



- 32 Glue the pre-shaped bud sepals around larger ball at the widest point.



- 33 Cover the remainder of the larger ball and the smaller ball with thin strip of juniper crepe paper and glue. Wrap 3-4 inches of the stem.



- 34 Use the tweezers to form the crepe paper around the small ball.



- 35 Arrange the sepals around the bud.



- 36 Follow the steps in the Garden Rose tutorial to create stems of leaf clusters.



- 37 Arrange and wrap stems to form a branch of one bloom and three buds.



- 38 Arrange and wrap stems to form a branch of two blooms and two buds.



- 39 Finish by wrapping to the base of the stem bundle.
