# MAKING YOUR GREENERY

TOOLS & MATERIALS

O CUTTING MACHINE (recommended)

O NEEDLE-NOSE TWEEZERS

O HOT GLUE GUN high temp

FLORAL TAPE bark, pine
SPRAY PAINT Blush (optional)

○ WIRE CUTTERS/NEEDLE-NOSE PLIERS

YOU WILL NEED:

O CRAFT SCISSORS

O CURLING TOOL

#### CUTTING

When using a Cricut, I find the best setting for cutting these green colors is **Copy Paper +more**. The ferns are very detailed so I do I recommend testing a corner of your paper with a small star to ensure your blade is sharp. If you are cutting by hand, we have provided a simplified template for this set of greenery.

FROSTED CRAFT PAPER Conifer Pack #2, Succulent Pack #2 & #4

PAPER COVERED WIRE 18-gauge green, 24-gauge green

#### **ASSEMBLING YOUR FERNS**

Leaving a quarter inch at the top, place a line of glue down the spine of the fern. Press the 24-gauge wire into the glue and let cool. Using the curling tool, shape the edges of the little fern fingers on both sides. Gather three ferns, stack to meet at base, and bundle the three stems together with floral tape. Gently bend the wires to create a fern cascade. Repeat to create three fern bundles.

### ASSEMBLING YOUR DUSTY MILLER

Use your curling tool to gently curl the tips of the dusty miller in one direction. Repeat with all cut shapes. Organize your pieces into sets of three. Starting with your larger dusty miller piece, place it on the table so the curl is towards the table. Add a line of hot glue onto the stem and place an 18-gauge wire tip onto the glue. On your second set of the three, hold with the curl towards the table and add hot glue to stem. Turn over and place onto right side of wired dusty miller. Repeat with third piece but place on left side of wire. Let cool, then arrange three pieces into triangle with tips curling outward. Repeat to create ten stems of dusty miller.



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### NOTES

#### ASSEMBLING YOUR GARDENIA LEAVES

Fold center of gardenia along the score line. With curling tool, shape on both sides of leaf. Repeat with all leaves. Arrange in clusters of three. With center leaf, add glue to center base and place 18-gauge wire onto glue and pinch paper around wire. For the second leaf, add glue to front base tip, place to the left behind the center leaf at an angle and wrap tip around wire. For the third leaf, add glue on back of base tip, place to the right in front of the center leaf and press glued tip against wire. An option to add a gradient to the leaves is to spray the tips with a pink spray paint. Repeat to create ten stems of gardenia leaves.
